- 9-inch x 12-inch White Adhesive-backed Felt (1 sheet)
- 9-inch x 12-inch Black Adhesive-backed Felt (1 sheet)
- 9-inch x 12-inch Charcoal Felt (2 sheets)
- 12-inch x 18-inch Lavender Felt (1 sheet)
- Assorted Color Chenille Stems (5)
- Sparkle Glitter Glue
- Glitter Dust
- Scissors
- Hole Punch
- Ruler
- Pencil

Cost of each project will vary depending on materials used.

Due to the seasonal nature of some merchandise, actual availability of some products pictured may vary.

Instructions

Print off the patterns and cut them out. Trace four ghosts on white felt, flipping every other ghost over to change its direction. Trace three bats on black felt. Cut out the shapes.

Stick the ghosts onto the charcoal felt (two ghosts will fit on a sheet). Stick the bats onto the lavender felt. Cut out the shapes close to the edges, leaving a narrow border showing.

Use the hole punch to put two holes in each bat and ghost.

Use glitter glue to give each ghost two large eyes. Cut out black oval shapes from scraps of black felt for mouths and adhere in place.

Use glitter glue to give each bat two small eyes. Sprinkle some of the glitter dust on the bat's eyes. Cut small white triangles from scraps of white felt for teeth and adhere in place.

Cut three chenille stems in half. Poke one end through the back of a ghost, and the other end through the back of a bat. Use the pencil to curl the ends. Connect all the bats and ghosts.

For hangers, poke one whole chenille stem through the front of the last ghost's hand. Keep the end longer in the back. Use the long end to attach the garland to a hook or nail. Curl each end of the chenille stem. Repeat for the other side.

Tip:

Use photo as a guide and follow manufacturer's instructions for all products used.

Ask an adult for help when using the scissors and hole punch.

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
